

Failure to catalog iPod content may limit the use of Voice Control to access Pode content. If music files stored on a USB device or SD card are played when the system is in Route Guidance Mode, the volume of the navigation guidance voice will be the same as the volume of the music files being played, even if a different "Master" or "Voice"
